

Enrichment Through Campus Ministry

The campus ministry program here at Mother Seton Academy continues to provide an array of experiences for the spiritual enrichment of our children. This past year we have prayed and served together in ways that have allowed our students to grow and prosper in faith.

We began the year with a prayer service where each student received a stole welcoming them to the new school year. The stole served as a symbolic reminder that God was covering and protecting them during their journey here at Mother Seton. A Thanksgiving Prayer breakfast, along with celebrations during the seasons of Advent, Lent and Easter, provided additional moments of building ourselves as a community.

During that Easter season last year the Baltimore riots occurred. That first morning back at school was truly memorable as we reflected on the fact that we were in the Easter season and that there was a great need for joy in our city. This was a significant teachable moment for our students. What we do in the prayer room each day connects in a very real way to the circumstances and realities of our neighborhood and the world abroad.

To nurture this need for our students to look outward, service projects are provided for them. The focus this past year has been to develop deepened relationships with our friends in the local neighborhood. We began the year with a clean-up of Mund Park. This project served as a visible

witness to the Greenmount corridor that there are young people who care about their neighborhood.

We also served at the Franciscan Center during their food distribution project. Our students unloaded numerous crates of food and bagged the items for the hungry of our neighborhood. Our relationship with the Barclay community continued with our work on a community garden which allowed our children to get dirty and watch things grow. The vegetables produced were given to the residents of Homewood House. We are excited to extend our efforts this year by connecting to the York Road corridor. In November we will serve that community with neighborhood clean-ups and work in the preservation forest.

At Mother Seton Academy we continuously talk about how blessed we are and that we have a responsibility to give back to the community. Both our students and families are required to give at least ten hours of service to the neighborhood. This spirit of giving is truly evident at MSA. Many of our families and students get well beyond the ten hours required. It is the building of these relationships that will propel our graduates to be productive leaders in the world and it is a blessing for us all to be a part of this blessed journey.



Students Thrive with Graduate Support

Choosing a high school that is the best fit and navigating the process to get there is complex. That is why support with high school exploration, applications, scholarships and financial aid, and eventually the acceptance and registration process is provided to every student at Mother Seton Academy. This is accomplished by High School Seminar classes, and meetings with students, parents and schools, along with many emails and phone calls. In addition to sharing information about high school fairs, open houses, Graduate Support assisted with scheduling over 65 shadow day experiences, interviews and testing, and the submission of student recommendations. For the nineteen scholars who applied to private schools, \$283,385 was offered in financial aid of which \$164,500 was accepted. This class had 79% enrolling in private high schools and 17% in selective public schools.

During the year, Graduate Support was also busy providing mentoring services to 89 MSA graduates in 31 high schools throughout Baltimore, connecting to counseling staff at the high schools and visiting the graduates at least once in the academic year. Quarterly report cards of all high school students were reviewed throughout the year and follow up was made with families and counselors when students needed support. Congratulatory emails and texts were sent to recognize graduates doing well or showing improvement. Examples of recent accomplishments include Jeremiah Garland '12 at Thurgood Marshall Academy who

is a National Society of High School Scholar and working on a book of his poems "Dreams" to be published in 2016 and is dually enrolled in high school and college. Roland Ellis '13, was recently selected as one of twenty teens in Baltimore to participate in a 15-month leadership program through Art with a Heart. Armoni Gaddy '13, also a National Honor Society member, was selected to participate in FAME (Foundation for the Advancement of Music and Education).

Graduate Support also hosted a college prep workshop and maintained contact with college counselors, students and families about college applications. Of the 21 graduates of the Class of 2011, 90% graduated in the spring of 2015, and 10% will graduate in 2016. One member of the Class of 2011, Cierra Chandler received a merit scholarship of \$20,000 from Northrup Grumman to attend Syracuse University.

Graduates Support also provides the opportunity for graduates to remain connected to Mother Seton Academy long after graduation. Graduates are encouraged to return to volunteer, support fund raisers, or attend a class reunion. Three reunions were hosted– one for recent 8th grade graduates, one for high school students, and one for MSA classes 2007-2011. Two of the many older graduate successes shared include Shaniqua Jones, St. Paul's School for Girls '11 who will graduate from Towson University in December in Accounting, and Diego Martinez, Mount Saint Joseph '11, who graduated from LaSalle University in May with a BS in Business and was recently hired at Morgan Stanley.

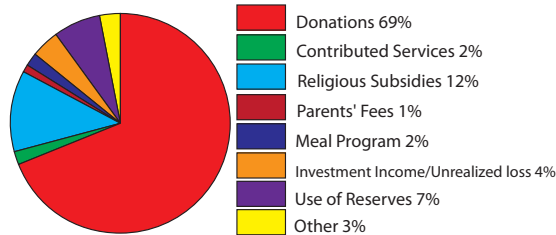

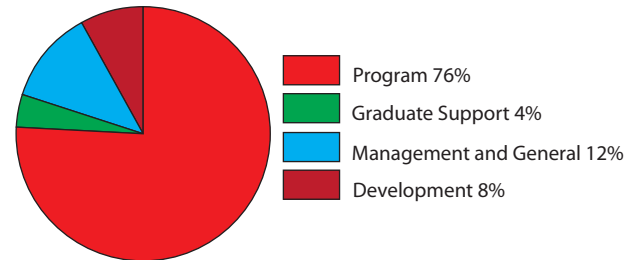
