Board Greetings



Our 8th grade class performed their individual speeches to the theme of "Wake Up the World." Graduate Highlights

We are delighted to share that in Spring 2016, 22 former MSA students graduated from high school, with a 100% acceptance rate into colleges. Twenty-one of these recent graduates are currently enrolled and one will begin during the Spring semester. We are especially proud of the college destinations which include Dickinson College, Frostburg State University, Hampton College, Salisbury University, Towson University, University of Baltimore, Wesley College and Wheeling Jesuit University.

In addition, we are also excited to share that the MSA Class of 2011 had a 100% high school graduation rate. Our graduates continue to make us proud in many other ways:

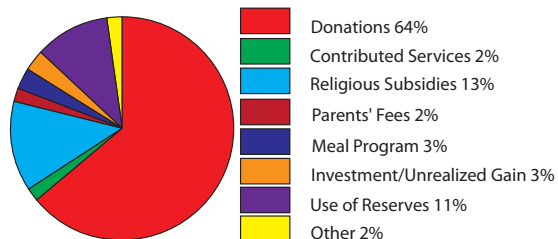

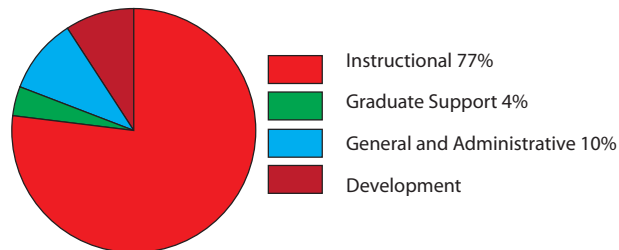
