

Community Connections

Mother Seton Academy (MSA) had the fantastic opportunity to team up with local partners, Clark Construction and the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA), earlier this year to beautify a building site during construction with a communal mural project coordinated and designed by art teacher, Kelsey Walsh, and the school's students.

To help gain a greater understanding about this project Clark Construction and the MTA gave a presentation to MSA's students about the vital role public transportation has in our city's operations, and the value new construction and increased job opportunities brings to Baltimore. The students enjoyed interacting with the speakers and asking questions about different modes of transportation and the ins and outs of what it's like on a construction site. Later, Ms. Walsh asked each of the art classes to create their own designs based on the presentation given with a focus on construction, transportation, the MTA, or Baltimore. Once all the ideas were submitted, Ms. Walsh incorporated the groups' designs into twelve main panels.

Ms. Walsh worked with Bro. Jesse O'Neil to get a group of MSA students and their parents together to join the staff from Clark Construction and the MTA on a Saturday afternoon to do the final painting of the panels, with the supplies generously donated by Clark Construction. This fun service project was not only educational for our students but also gave our partners the opportunity to share in the joy of working together with the MSA students in a wonderful collaboration that added beauty to our community.

Graduate Highlights

Earlier this year, our Office of Graduate Support took Mother Seton Academy (MSA) alumni on an exploration of potential college campuses. Our first group of fifteen, including graduates, family members, and MSA staff, were treated to a guided tour of Salisbury University given by Andrew Britt a current student of Salisbury and former MSA graduate (Class of '12). The next outing to the University of Maryland, Baltimore County was organized by Lisa Knickmeyer, the Director of Graduate Support, gave the graduates the chance to explore the campus and get an inside look at the class structures and amenities of the facility. Both trips provided a wonderful opportunity for MSA graduates to get a firsthand look at what a college campus is like, how classes are taught, and the differences between universities.

This selective program exposes high school students to business, college, career, and life concepts not typically addressed in the typical school atmosphere.

Janiah Tillery, '13, is attending Roanoke College in Salem, VA to study biology/pre-med on a full financial aid package. In addition to her studies, she has assumed leadership of the college's Weightlifting Club, a passion she developed at the Mission Fit, a free gym for Baltimore Youth.






