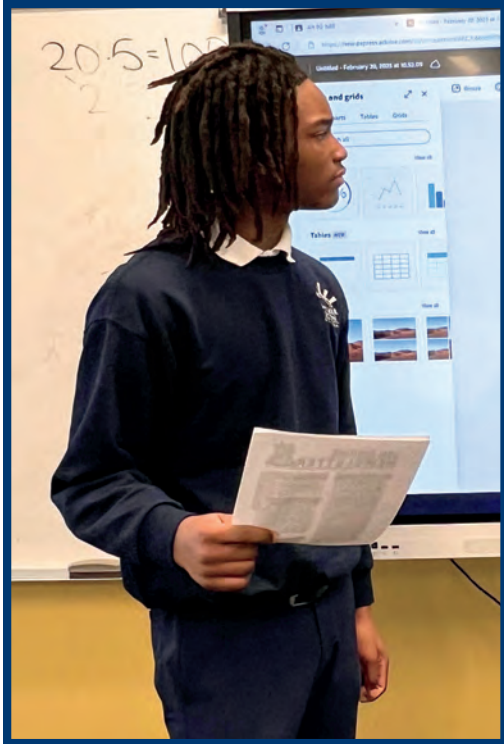

staff and administration work so diligently to challenge the students to realize their God-given talents and to make a difference in the community around them. During 2023-24 we celebrated a milestone in the life of Mother Seton Academy. We marked the thirtieth anniversary of the school's service to our students and families. We trace our commitment to Catholic education in Baltimore back to Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, our patron. In 1808, soon after arriving from New York City, she opened her tuition-free school on Paca Street, just a few short miles from where MSA is alive and flourishing.

The school community also marked the retirement of Sister Peggy Juskelis, SSND, who had served as President of Mother Seton Academy for twelve years. Many of you met her, corresponded with her and

collaborated with her during that time of growth and blessings. Sister Peggy's contributions are too many to count but I would like to highlight a few. Her efforts led to an increase in enrollment and a retention of quality faculty and staff. She expanded outreach to neighborhood organizations and to local and state governments. Very significantly, Sister Peggy undertook a capital campaign that produced a state-of-the-art gymnasium and other improvements in the landscaping, technology and physical plant of the school. She was committed to having green space around our campus and focused on making our new gym building environmentally friendly with the addition of solar panels. We are proud that the gym has since inspired a lot of renovations and improvements throughout the neighborhood. Many of these successes would not have taken place without the generosity of you, our donors. On behalf of the Board of Directors, I want to express my gratitude to Sister Peggy for her years of collaboration with us for the benefit of the entire MSA family.

Thank you for the kindness and support you have shown to Mother Seton Academy, especially during the past year. I know that I can count on your continued support as Mr. George Andrews takes on his role as the new president to lead us into the future. May God bless each of you and your loved ones.

Community Day

Genesee Valley

Each year, we partner with The School of Cathedral of Mary Our Queen for unforgettable collaborative experiences. This year's we went to the Genesee Valley ropes course. This adventure allows our students to practice teamwork, overcome challenges, and build friendships with their peers from our sister school. It's an invaluable opportunity for personal growth and connection.



St. Joseph's Advent Trip

Baltimore Museum of Industry

Our eighth graders had the opportunity to visit the Baltimore Museum of Industry, where they learned about the history of labor and how it impacted Baltimore. Students also participated in a complex design challenge called Balls and Tracks. Students designed roller coasters for marbles, applying their knowledge of physical science while engaging in hands-on problem-solving. This trip brought classroom lessons to life in an exciting, interactive way.

Masonville Cove

Students visited Living Classrooms’ Masonville Cove, the nation’s first urban wildlife refuge, where they learned about different ecosystems and explored the wonders of nature. This hands-on experience, which included examining organisms under a microscope and interacting with animals, left our students with a deeper appreciation for environmental science.

River Farm Trip

Our 7th graders spent a day at River Farm Camp, enjoying activities like

swimming, kayaking, and dodgeball. This trip not only provided them with a fun-filled day outside but also allowed students to bond and build friendships before beginning their final year at MSA.
