



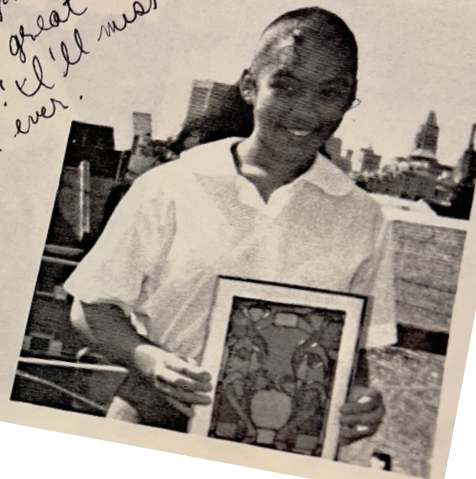

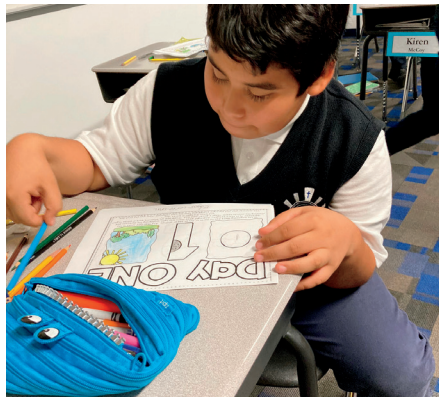

Cape May

This isn't just any trip - it's a pilgrimage for MSA students to unwind, reflect, and cherish the relationships they've built. This time honored tradition still shines brightly today. For four days, students enjoy the sun, sand, and sea as they solidify their class ties. It is an opportunity to reflect while taking inventory of their journey and to enjoy the company of their classmates. They create lasting memories at Cape May, the culmination of the incredible personal transformation they've undergone.



The Cord Ceremony

At Mother Seton Academy, we believe in celebrating each step that brings students closer to their successful completion of middle school. The Cord Ceremony is a special event held in September where we recognize our students' hard work and dedication to their academic goals. Each cord represents a year of commitment and achievement, and we couldn't be prouder of our students' accomplishments.



Annual Reunion for MSA Graduates in High School

Lisa Knickmeyer started the Graduate Reunion in November of 2011. After meeting with MSA graduates during the high school “check in” visits, many students expressed that they wanted an opportunity to come back to MSA and reconnect with their classmates, since they were spread out attending different high schools. It was clear to Ms. Knickmeyer there was a nostalgia for their beloved middle school and a reunion gave them a chance to collectively reminisce about their experience at MSA.

The Annual Graduate Reunion is also a great way to strengthen our connection with graduates. It reminds them that MSA is a good place to give back when it comes to community service hours, or in other ways, now and in the future.



The 2 hour event includes a reflection piece, dinner, basketball and socializing in the gym. We usually have a great turn out with between 35-50% of the invitees attending. The feedback we receive has been very positive with a renewed interest every year. The most recent reunion, the MSA classes of 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023, totaling 102 graduates, were invited. Having the new gym has been a wonderful addition to the event. It has allowed lively, spirited and healthy “playtime”. As one MSA faculty member described it, “It’s like full-on high school recess.”

Speeches

Speeches have taken many forms and iterations depending on the teacher or staff member that runs the event. Working with the 8th grade, our speeches function as a capstone project that truly highlights their ability to research, analyze, synthesize, and compile information to present to others. Students spend January-May conducting a research project on a topic of their own choosing. With the guidance of our ELA teacher, Liane Kittrell, students write research questions, papers, and ultimately compile a presentation and slideshow from this research. Speeches show the 8th grade's ability to perform an intensive project, managing a myriad of time tables and check points, to speak about what they are passionate about.



Album Day

Album Day was started in 2023 by MSA principal Dr. Gregory Sucre. The prayer breakfast and service organized by Campus Minister Guin Phoebe and celebrated by Father Joe Muth honors our 8th grade and their families the week before graduation. This event is an opportunity for students to come together, wear their high school spirit wear, and gather signatures from their classmates as well as family members and friends. This event marks the last day of school for the 8th grade before embarking on the next phase of their academic journey. On our first Album day, the Assembly Hall was transformed by parents into an exciting reception space replete with graduation decor. Breakfast was served by the 7th grade and their families. Seeing our students wearing sweat shirts, hats and tees emblazoned with the names of their high school was so exciting. We can't wait for our next Album Day!



Community Service

At MSA, we believe in the power of giving back. We are part of a community that understands that even small acts of kindness can make a big difference. That's why we require our students and parents to complete 10 hours of community service each year. We're proud to say that together, we've recorded over 1600 service hours in the 2022-2023 academic year alone. From donations to nursing homes to creating coloring books for kids, our community is making a real impact.

Poetry Outlook

From tradition to expansion.

Poetry Out Loud has been an annual tradition at Mother Seton Academy since before 2015, but it wasn't until Ms. Liane Kittrell came aboard that it gained new momentum. In 2017, Ms. Kittrell worked with Guin Phoebe to expand the event to include the 7th grade. The 8th grade students wrote and performed their own poetry, while the 7th graders found a previously published poem to recite.

When Ms. Kittrell became the 8th grade ELA and LIT teacher, she took over the entirety of the event in 2019 and has run it since.

Poetry Out Loud is an exceptional event that allows teachers, students, families, and special guests to enjoy creativity and performance by the 7th and 8th grade students. It is always held the last day of school before Christmas break and is a time to gather socially around the theme of the event that year.



Students have a lot to say about the world and the community in which they live. Poetry Out Loud offers them a creative and alternative space to voice their thoughts. We often have poem topics ranging from love of self, to gun violence issues, to odes and love for family members, to the way hair feels! The breadth and depth of the performance resonates with all in attendance.

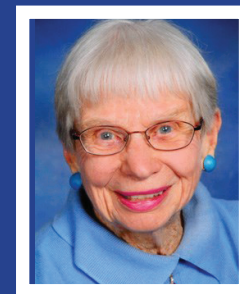

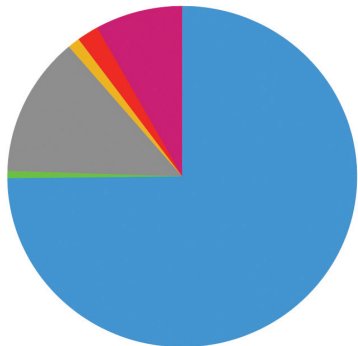

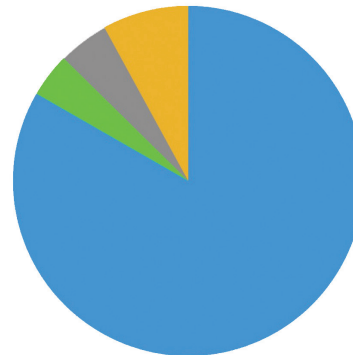
