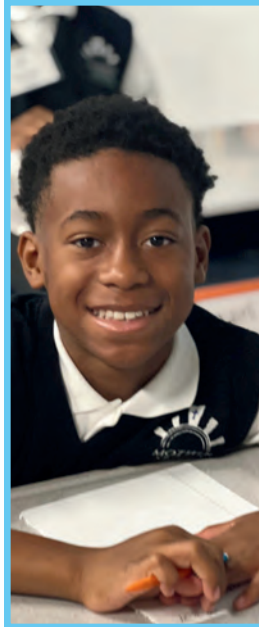

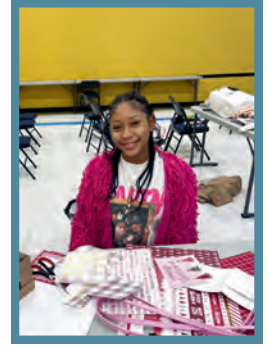

Together, they cleaned a four-block radius around campus, fostering a sense of ownership and pride while encouraging neighbors to continue caring for the shared community.

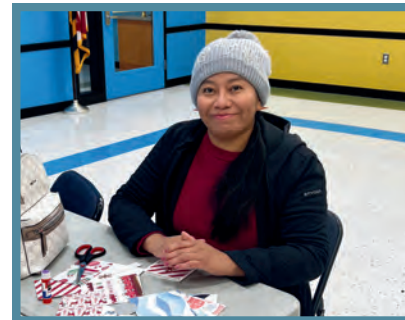
As a school community, Mother Seton Academy also participated in the Kennedy Krieger Festival of Trees. Students and their families worked together to create ornaments to help raise funds in support of Kennedy Krieger and its mission to serve children and families.



In addition, MSA students and families partnered to support the Villa Maria School during the Christmas season. Families collected new gift items such as coloring books, graphic novels, craft kits, Legos, and puzzles. They then came together to create cards and wrap gifts for residents who would be spending Christmas at the school, spreading joy and compassion during the holiday season.

These milestone gatherings celebrated the lasting impact of an MSA education and strengthened the connections that continue to inspire alumni to support and uplift the next generation of scholars.

An Evening of Connection and Celebration:

Mother Seton Academy hosted an alumni happy hour, welcoming more than 50 alumni for an evening of connection and celebration at Riverside Taphouse in Federal Hill. The event created a new space for adult alumni to reconnect with one another and with the school that helped shape their paths. The strong turnout and enthusiasm reflected the deep, enduring bonds within the MSA community and the pride alumni carry in being part of its mission.



Back on Campus, Forward in Purpose: Our alumni cookout brought adult alumni back to campus for an evening of fellowship, reflection, and celebration. For many attendees, it was their first opportunity to see our current school building, which we moved into in 2009, and they were inspired by how far Mother Seton Academy has come since opening in 1993. Alumni toured the campus, including the gym added in 2020, a space many had never experienced before. Seeing the growth and expanded opportunities available to today's students reignited excitement and pride, motivating alumni to consider how they can give back to support students who are now in their former shoes.

Driving Impact on and off the Course

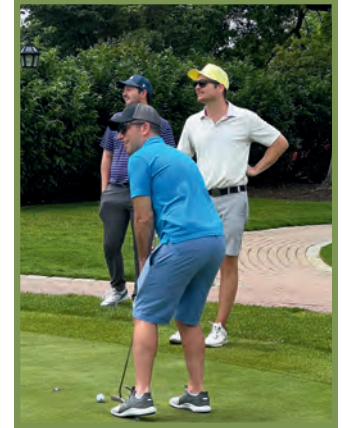

Together, we accomplished something truly meaningful, strengthening our school community and expanding opportunities for the students we serve.

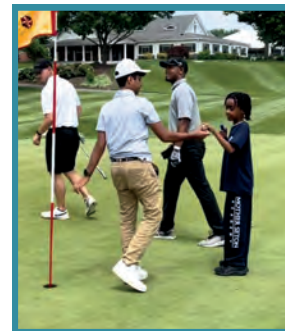


Expanding Opportunities Beyond the School Day



Mother Seton Academy's extended day program plays a vital role in supporting the whole student by offering enriching opportunities beyond the traditional school day. During the 2024 to 2025 school year, these efforts were strengthened with the addition of a full-time physical education teacher and extended day clubs coordinator, Marty Knox, known to students as Coach Marty.

Coach Marty is a longtime member of the MSA community and has served as our basketball coach for many years. He brings more than a decade of experience working with youth at the high school level as a paraeducator and behavior specialist, in addition to his coaching background.



His commitment to mentorship, physical education, and leadership has infused new energy into MSA's enrichment and athletic programming. In addition to expanding leadership capacity, Mother Seton Academy invested in a new twelve passenger van, significantly increasing access to off campus enrichment opportunities.

This resource has allowed clubs and teams to travel to new locations, including Clay Club visits to Baltimore Clayworks, Swimming Club trips to the YMCA, Golf Club outings at Clifton Park, and transportation for the soccer team to practices. Together, these investments have expanded what is possible for students, ensuring they can explore new interests, develop skills, and build confidence beyond the classroom.

Celebrating 600 Graduates and Counting

With the Class of 2025's graduation, Mother Seton Academy proudly reached a historic milestone of more than 600 graduates. This moment is a testament not only to the students' perseverance and achievement, but the unwavering commitment of the community that stands behind them.

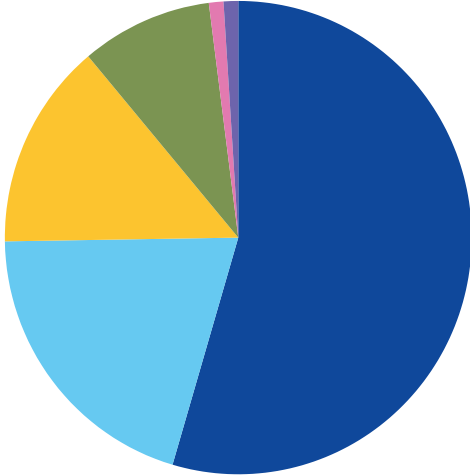

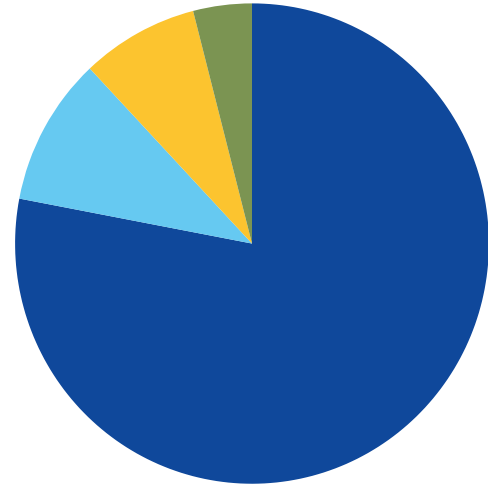

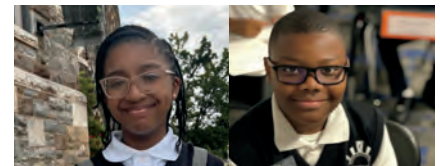
